


Words to Know

Criss Cross



ACROSS

2. Area that is considered dry ground and does not exhibit any characteristics of a wetland
6. Any body of water that has salinity above 30 ppt
10. Small particles that are created through natural processes of weathering (wind) and erosion (water) and carried by wind or water
14. Small islands that arise in the marsh
15. Concave curve shape of the US coastline from North Carolina to Southern Florida, causing the remarkable difference between high and low tides
19. Any body of water that has salinity of less than 0.5 ppt.
20. Geological depression that allows for the accumulation of water
22. A type of plant similar to grasses but generally found in wetter regions, with a square or triangular stem

DOWN

1. An area of land that all drains into a common body of water
3. Rivers characterized by wide, deep channels with slow moving water
4. Loose, scattered fragments of naturally occurring substances (rock) or manmade (wreckage)
5. Any body of water with a salinity between 0.5-30 ppt
7. Where a river meets a large body of water
8. Relating to or effected by tides
9. Amount of dissolved salt in water
11. Partly enclosed coastal body of brackish water with one or more rivers or streams flowing into it, and with a free connection to the open sea
12. What a body of water (usually a river) flows through. It is defined by a bed (bottom) and banks (side)
13. A large ocean inlet, or a narrow ocean channel between two bodies of land
16. Cloudiness or haziness of a fluid caused by large numbers of individual particles that are generally invisible to the naked eye, similar to smoke in air
17. A type of plant similar to grasses but generally found in wetter regions with a round stem
18. A low, flat wetland that is generally in the intertidal zone between the land and sea. Characterized by species of grasses, sedges, and rushes that can tolerate salt water
21. Area that is dominated by water, which results in unique flora and fauna that are adapted to watery conditions
